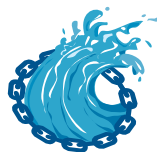


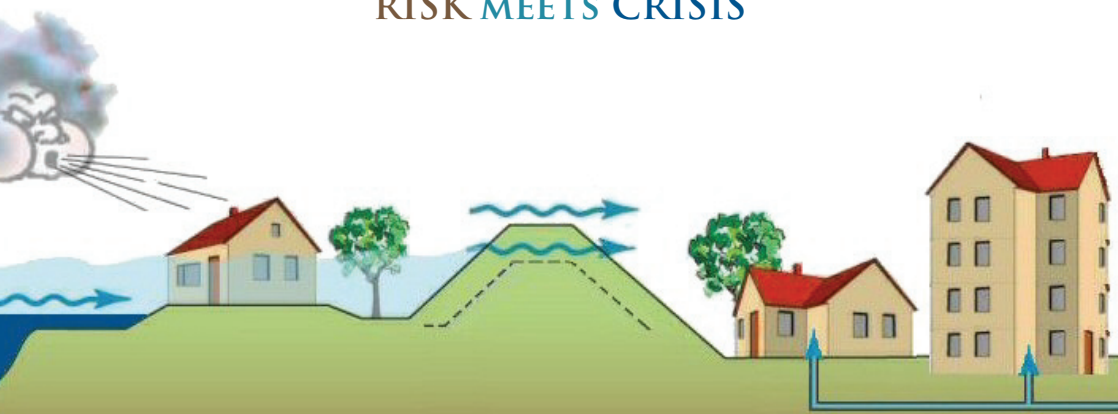

The EU Interreg North Sea Programme projects SAFECOAST and CHAIN OF SAFETY present their joint FINAL CONFERENCE on **MAY 21-22, 2008** in the Carlton Beach Hotel, Scheveningen, The Netherlands.

Project Safecoast takes both a technical and strategic view from coastal flood and erosion risk management. The project brings together coastal managers and researchers to create a common understanding of the same problem: coastal flooding and erosion risks along the North Sea coasts. It is learning by doing: interpreting sea level rise and socio-economic scenarios, performing risk assessments at various levels, organizing communication campaigns, sharing data and information, and making contemplative maps that overcome national borders. Safecoast is all about coastal flood risk management.
